

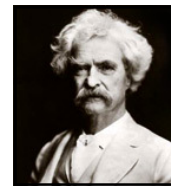


## MARK TWAIN & HARRIET BEECHER STOWE Historic House Tour Thursday, Oct 7

Did you know that Mark Twain, author of “*Adventures of Tom Sawyer*” and “*Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*” and Harriet Beecher Stowe, author of “*Uncle Tom’s Cabin*” were next door neighbors in Hartford??? Our day will begin with a lecture on “Stowe & Twain: Effecting Social Change”. The books will be put in proper historical context to enhance understanding of how these books had such a profound influence on race relations in the U.S. over the past 150 years and why they continue to have relevance to our cross-cultural dialog even today.
