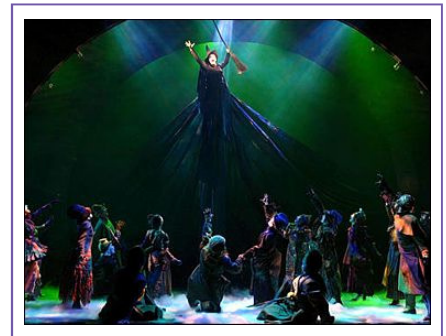




WICKED
